

ACP Example Items

Local Assessment has developed a representative set of items for each ACP. The purpose of these Example Items is for teachers to gain an understanding of the format and rigor of the ACPs. The Example Items are available for download, and teachers can use these items, along with the test blueprint, as a guide for preparing students for the ACP. Each Example Item has the correct answer as well as the content SE the item is intended to measure listed.

Example Items represent, not give away, the ACP. The number of Example Items is a small portion of the number of items on the actual test, and is representative of the format and rigor. However, items appearing on the ACP are not limited to the format appearing in the Example Items. Example Items are intended to provide an understanding of some, not all, possible approaches to assessing the given SE. The specific part of an SE that an Example Item measures is not necessarily the only part of the SE assessed on the ACP. None of these Example Items will appear on the ACP.
